




PNR 12K—12mm x 30mm Bar Rail Chairs

Please read this instruction leaflet in it's entirety before attempting to assemble and use your new product








A full length of bar rail should have the chairs added (recommended spacing 300mm between centres when used on PNR-12I narrow gauge sleepers) before attempting to screw them to your sleepers

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
1. To Assemble Track on Gauge

All three chairs with indication arrows pointing inwards



2. To Assemble Track Over Gauge

Turn single chair by 180 degrees so that all arrows are pointing in the same direction


Additional part required PNR-12L—10mm x 20mm Bar Rail Chair





1. To Assemble Track on Gauge


All three chairs and spacer with indication arrows pointing inwards



2. To Assemble Track with Gauge Widening

Leave this chair but turn spacer by 180 degrees so that all arrows are pointing in the same direction

Turn single chair by 180 degrees so that all arrows are pointing in the same direction



Safety
